Academic and Institutional Developments

We are happy to share a few important academic and institutional developments for the coming year. Nursery has now been introduced, providing greater convenience for families with younger siblings and ensuring continuity of learning within the same campus from the early years onward. This initiative strengthens our early childhood foundation while offering a smooth transition into higher grades.

We are also pleased to introduce a specialised JEE preparation programme for students in Grades 9, 10, and 11. This structured, school-integrated programme will build strong conceptual foundations and problem-solving skills, helping students prepare in a stress-free manner for reputed engineering and medical institutes in India.

Enhancing Learning Through EdTech

For Grades 7 and 8, we will introduce EdTech tools using school-provided devices to enhance personalised and competency-based learning. Platforms such as Formative, Exact Path, and Edge will support real-time assessment, targeted academic growth in core subjects, and the development of essential life competencies.

These tools enable teachers to provide timely feedback, identify learning gaps, and personalise instruction to ensure stronger academic outcomes.

Strengthening Teacher Stability

We have also taken significant steps to strengthen teacher retention, including linking staff benefits to staff stability, enhanced health insurance, leadership opportunities, and clear professional growth pathways. We are confident that these measures will lead to greater continuity in teaching and further enhance the learning experience of our students.

Campus Expansion

Our new Block 3 will be operational from Academic Year 2026–27. Built to support our growing community, this expansion reflects our belief in being a school of choice for families seeking an environment where learning comes first and strong academics, character, and opportunity come together in equal measure.

These new spaces have been designed to nurture curious and confident minds and to strengthen the culture we value deeply - one where confidence grows through meaningful learning experiences, strong teacher student relationships, and a balanced focus on both achievement and well-being.

Strengthening Our Sports Ecosystem

Alongside this academic expansion, we are investing further in our sports ecosystem. By June 2026, our campus will feature a turf football field and an enhanced running track, ensuring our students have access to facilities that support fitness, teamwork, and a competitive spirit.

A vibrant sports culture is central to building resilience and self-belief, and these additions will play an important role in shaping well-rounded learners.

Technology Enhancements for Communication and Safety

We are also introducing key technology enhancements to strengthen communication and student safety. A structured ticketing system will streamline parent communication by enabling direct connections with the relevant team, supported by defined SLAs and a clear escalation mechanism for timely resolution.

In addition, the Together School Transport App is being implemented to provide real-time bus tracking, live location updates, estimated arrival times, and instant notifications for pick-up and drop-off. We have already shared the information with parents on how to access these services. We will soon introduce a unified digital dashboard that integrates all school applications into a single platform for parents, making it easier for them to access and use school services.
